



# FoneSync Manual

**Thank you for choosing  
FoneSync for Samsung phones**

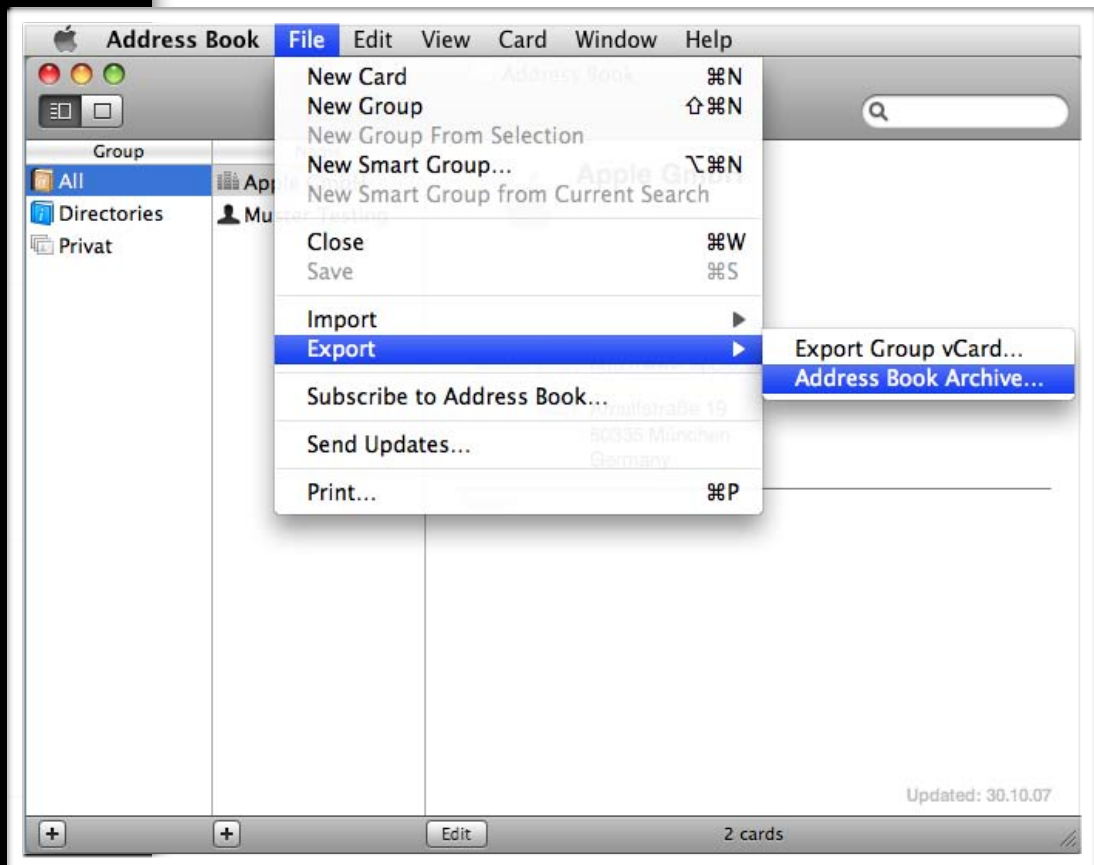
This software enables you to synchronise contacts and calendar entries between a Samsung phone and Mac OS X.

The [demoverision](#) will synchronise the first 5 contacts of your address book and the last 5 calendar events to your LG phone. It can not copy data from the phone to your Macintosh.

As soon as you activate the full version, these limitations will be removed.

# Backing up your data

In order to prevent any loss of data in Address Book or iCal, you should backup this data.



To back up your Address Book data on your computer:

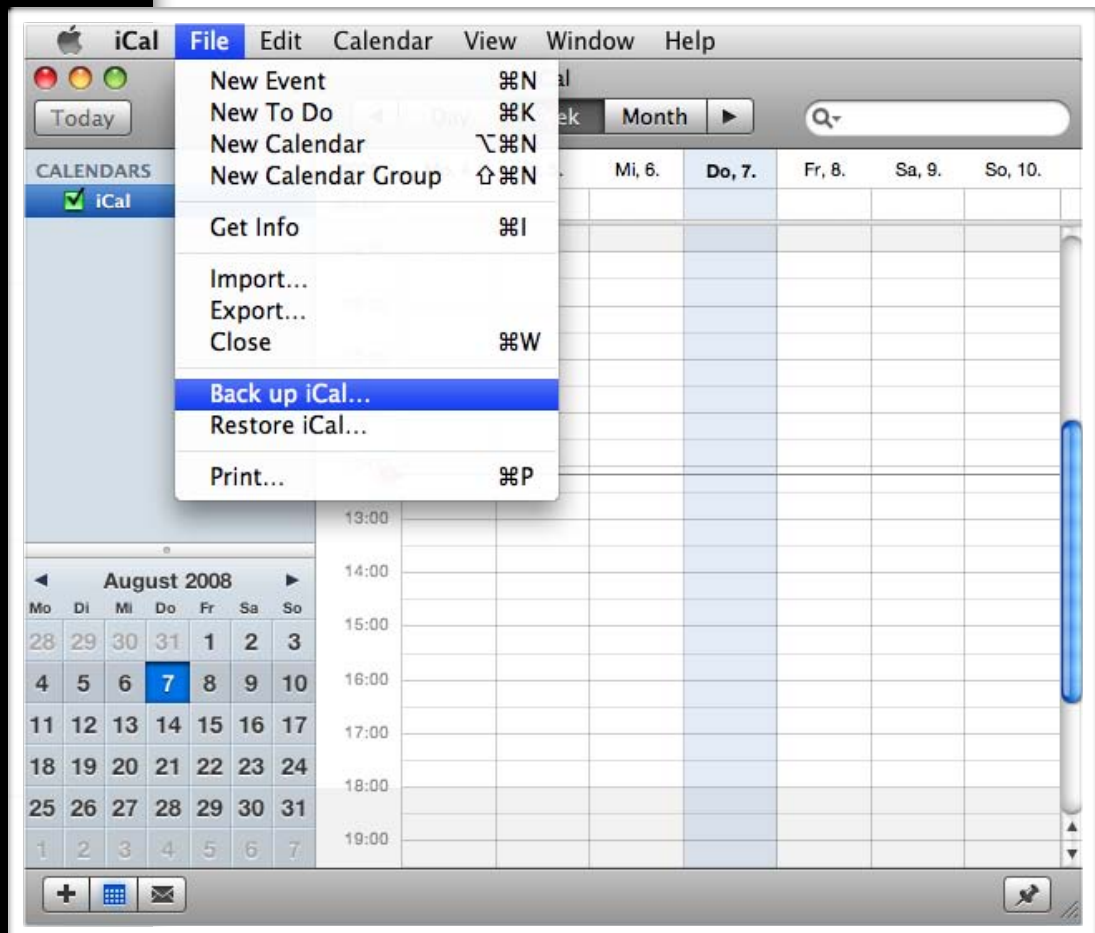
- 1 Open Address Book.
- 2 Click **File > Export > Address Book Archive...**

To recover Address Book data on your computer

- 1 Open Address Book
- 2 Click **File > Import > Address Book Archive....**
- 3 Select the backup file you previously saved.

# Backing up your data

To backup your iCal data on your computer:



- 1 Open iCal
- 2 Click **File > Back up iCal...**

To recover your iCal data

- 1 open iCal
- 2 Click **File > Restore iCal**
- 3 Select the backup file you previously saved.

(These menus can look different in earlier versions of Mac OS X)

# Connecting your phone

FoneSync supports Bluetooth connections as well as USB connections.

**Attention: Currently, only the S5230 can be synchronised using a USB connection.**

## Connect using USB:

1. On the phone, switch to **Settings > Phone settings > PC connections** and choose **Samsung PC studio**.
2. On the phone, switch to the main menu.
3. Attach the USB cable to your phone and then to your Macintosh computer.
4. Launch FoneSync.

## Connect using Bluetooth:

If you have already paired your phone with your Mac, you can skip this step.

1. Make sure Bluetooth is activated on your Mac and on your cell phone. The cell phone has to be set to be visible, so the Mac can detect it.
2. Open **System Preferences > Bluetooth** and click **Set Up new device** or click the + icon.

# Connecting your phone

This will open the Bluetooth Setup Assistant of Mac OS X which will guide you through the necessary steps to connect your cell phone with your Macintosh computer.

**Important:** Click **Continue** until the Bluetooth Assistant is finished, you do **not** need to enter any data or to change any settings.

### 3. Switch off confirmation requests.

Within the Bluetooth settings of the Samsung phone, select your Mac in the list of paired devices.

Authorize the Mac, so that your phone will accept connection requests from the Mac **without** further confirmation.

Otherwise the phone will ask you to confirm any change and this might interrupt the sync process.

### 4. Switch the phone to the main screen.

Samsung phones need to be switched to the main screen to be synchronised correctly.

# Using FoneSync

## Launch FoneSync

After connecting your phone with your Macintosh via Bluetooth or USB, you can launch FoneSync.

You will be asked to add a phone for synchronisation.



Click **Add phone**.

# Using FoneSync

You will see a list of paired phones. Click on the phone you want to use.



If you do not see your phone here, make sure the phone displays the main menu and no submenu is selected.

If you use Bluetooth, make sure it is enabled on the Mac and the phone and the phone is paired with the Mac. Within the Bluetooth settings of the Samsung phone, select your Mac in the list of paired devices. Authorize the Mac, so that your phone will accept connection requests from the Mac without further confirmation requests.

To start synchronizing your data, you will have to activate FoneSync, which is a one-time process.

# Activating FoneSync

FoneSync needs to be activated to be able to synchronize your data.



Click **Activate FoneSync** to open the activation window. This window prompts you to enter a valid activation key for FoneSync. If you do not have one, you can buy one at our online store at: <http://www.novamedia.de>

Next, enter your e-mail address, click **Continue** and accept the license terms.

Click **Finish** to switch back to FoneSync once the activation has been successful.

**Important:** To use your FoneSync license on another computer, you have to deactivate your license first. Click **FoneSync > Deactivate license...** to free your license. Then activate FoneSync on the other Mac.

# Synchronising data

If you start the synchronisation for the first time, FoneSync will ask you how to proceed with the data already stored on the phone.



You can choose one of these options:

**Merge data on phone and Mac.** Contacts of the phone will be copied to the Mac and contacts of the Mac will be copied to the phone. Duplicated entries will be deleted.

**Delete data on the phone.** The data on the phone will be erased and replaced by the data on the Mac.

Click **Close** when you have selected the desired options. Soon after that, you can start to synchronise your contacts, calendar entries or both.

# Synchronising data

To start synchronising your data, click on the appropriate button **Sync Contacts**, **Sync Calendar** or **Sync All**.



**Important:** Depending on the number of contacts and/or calendar entries, the sync process may take a few minutes.

To further define your synchronisation options, e.g. to sync selected contacts and calendars only, click **Sync settings**.

# Sync settings

You will see a new window, displaying the sync options, starting with the general settings.

## Settings:



Select which device should be preferred if a contact has changed on the Macintosh computer and on the mobile phone.

# Sync settings

Synchronising contacts:

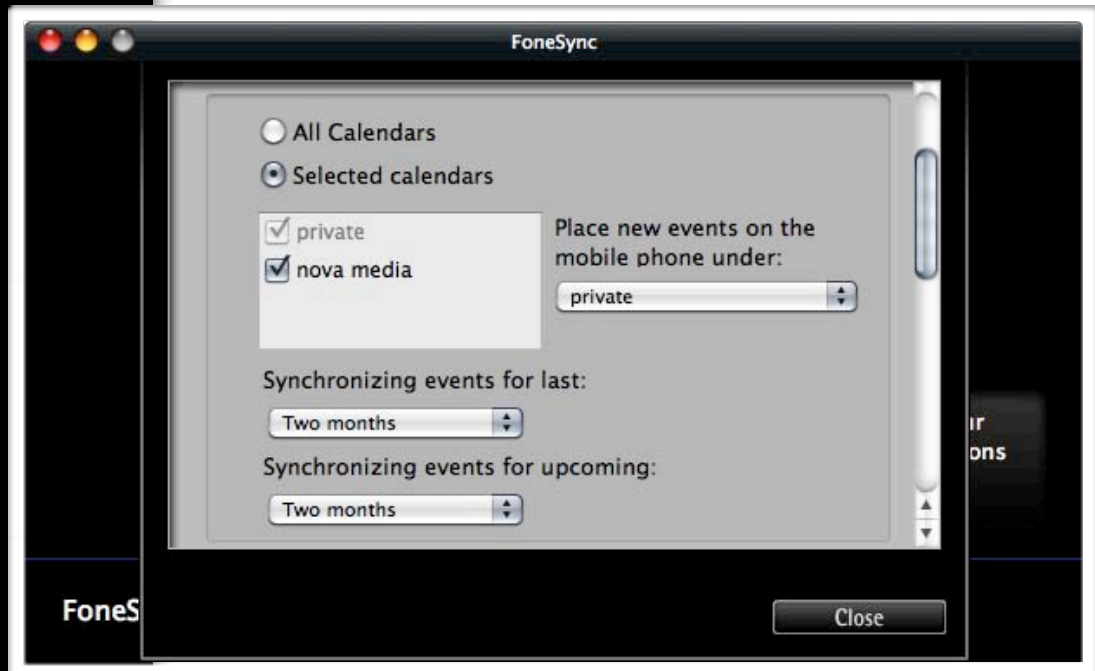


Choose here, if you want to synchronise all contacts or specific address book groups. New contact entries on the phone can be allocated to a specific group.

If you want to synchronize only contacts including a telephone number, check the appropriate box.

# Sync settings

## Synchronising calendars:



Choose here, if you want to synchronise all calendars or specific calendars only. New calendar entries on the phone can be allocated to a specific calendar.

In addition, you can determine the time frame in which calendar entries will be synchronized with the phone.

# FoneSync support

## How to uninstall FoneSync

To uninstall FoneSync, drag and drop the application in the trash bin and empty the trash.

## How to use FoneSync on another Macintosh

To use your FoneSync license on another computer, you have to deactivate your license first. Click **FoneSync > Deactivate license...** to free your license. Then activate FoneSync on the other Mac.
