

Phone plugins Manual



Thank you for using Phone plugins

This Software allows you to quick-dial and quick-send a text message to a selected number in the Address Book or any other Application.

Please follow the instructions on the next pages to use Phone plugins.

Until you register Phone plugins, the software will run in demo mode. Any text message can only be up to 80 characters long and you will see a 'Nag Screen' for a certain time after each issued call or send text message.

Pairing your cell phone

First of all, you need to pair your phone with your Mac. If your phone is already paired with your Mac, you can skip this step.

Open the System Preferences and click the Phone plugins preference pane > Select Cell Phone.



Be sure to have Bluetooth enabled on your Macintosh Computer as well as on your cell phone and click 'Launch Bluetooth Assistant'.

Pairing your cell phone

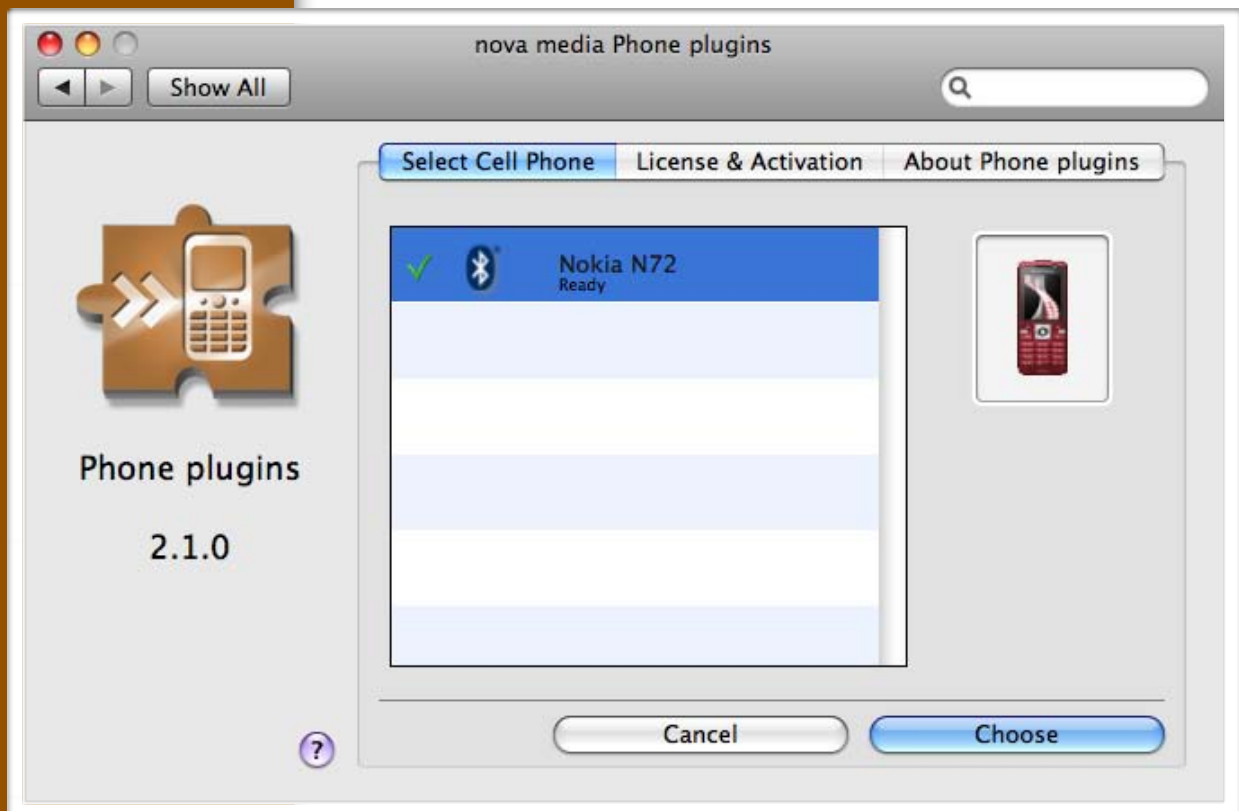
This will open the Bluetooth Setup Assistant of Mac OS X which will guide you through the necessary steps to connect your cell phone with your Macintosh computer.

Important: Click Continue until the Bluetooth Assistant is finished, you do not need to enter any data or to change any settings.

After the pairing process is finished, quit the Apple Bluetooth Assistant.

Selecting your cell phone

Make sure Bluetooth is activated on the Mac and the cell phone. Open the System Preferences and click the Phone plugins preference pane > Select Cell Phone.



You see a list of available cell phones. Select the cell phone from the list and click 'Choose' to use it with Phone plugins.

Attention: Some cell phones disable the Bluetooth detection after a while, so you might have to enable it again.

Activating Phone plugins

To send text messages longer than 80 characters and to get rid of the ,Nag Screen', Phone plugins needs to be activated.

Activate Phone plugins

To activate Phone plugins, open the system preferences ,Phone plugins' and choose the tab ,License & Activation'. Next, click ,Activate...'

You will see a new window which prompts you to enter a valid activation key for Phone plugins.

Next, please enter your e-mail address and click "Continue". You will have to accept the license terms. Click "Finish" to switch back to Phone plugins once the activation has been successful.

Deactivating Phone plugins

If you ever change your Macintosh Computer and want to take Phone plugins with you, you will have to deactivate Phone plugins on the old Macintosh Computer first.

Deactivate Phone plugins

To deactivate Phone plugins, open the system preferences ,Phone plugins‘ and choose the tab ,License & Activation‘. Next, click ,Deactivate License...‘

Phone plugins will now fall back into the demo mode.

After the deactivation, you can use your activation code to either activate Phone plugins on this computer again or activate Phone plugins on another Macintosh Computer of your choice.

Attention: If you choose to uninstall Phone plugins, your license information will still be saved on this computer and you can not use your activation key on any other Macintosh.

Be sure to deactivate your license if you need to use Phone plugins on another computer.

Quick-dial from the Address Book

In the Address Book application, open the desired contact and click on the label of the phone number you want your cell phone to dial:



Your cell phone will now dial the selected number and you will see a message on the screen:



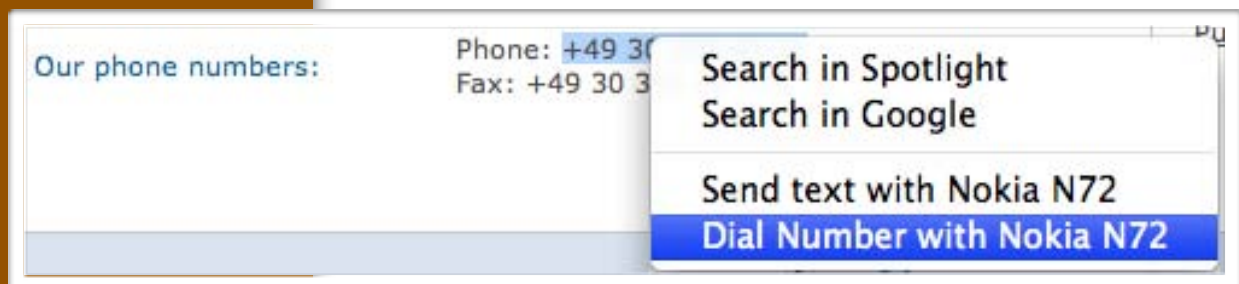
You can now choose to Hang Up or use your cell phone to talk to the contact you just dialed the number of.

Quick-dial using the context menu

Phone plugins allows you to use the context menu to access the ,Dial' and ,Send text' commands.

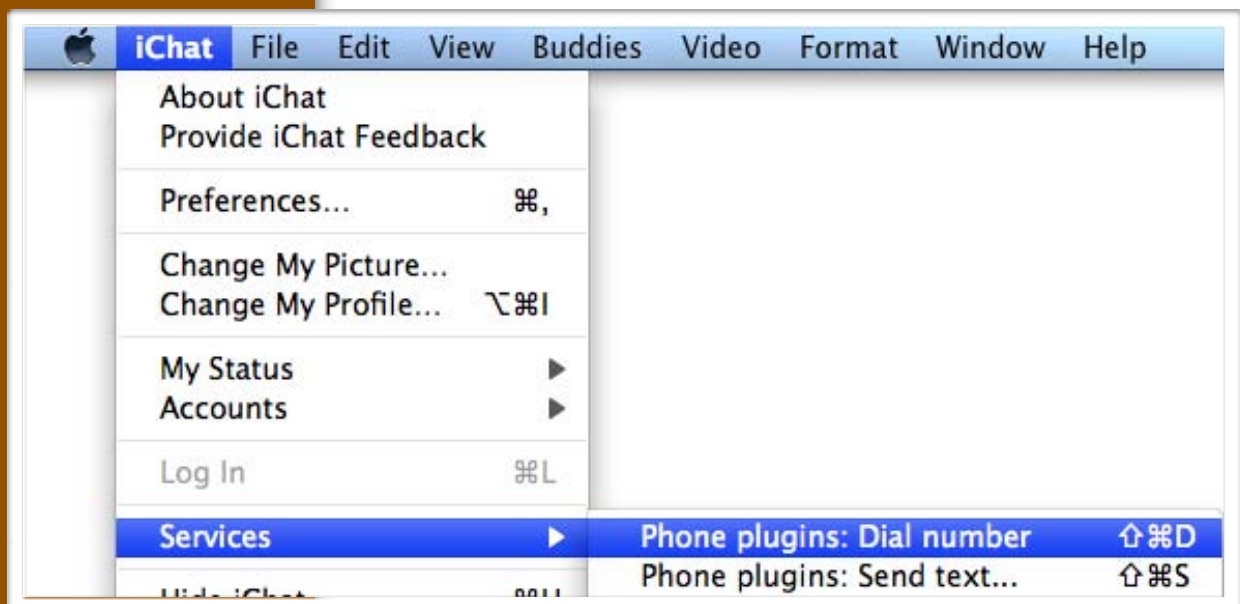

Then open the 'Services' menu and select ' Phone plugins: Dial number', to issue a call.



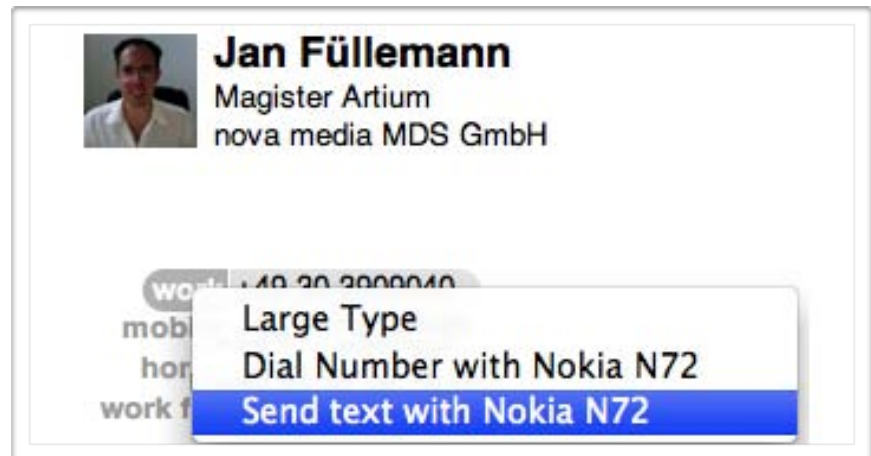
Your cell phone will now dial the selected number and you will see a message on the screen:



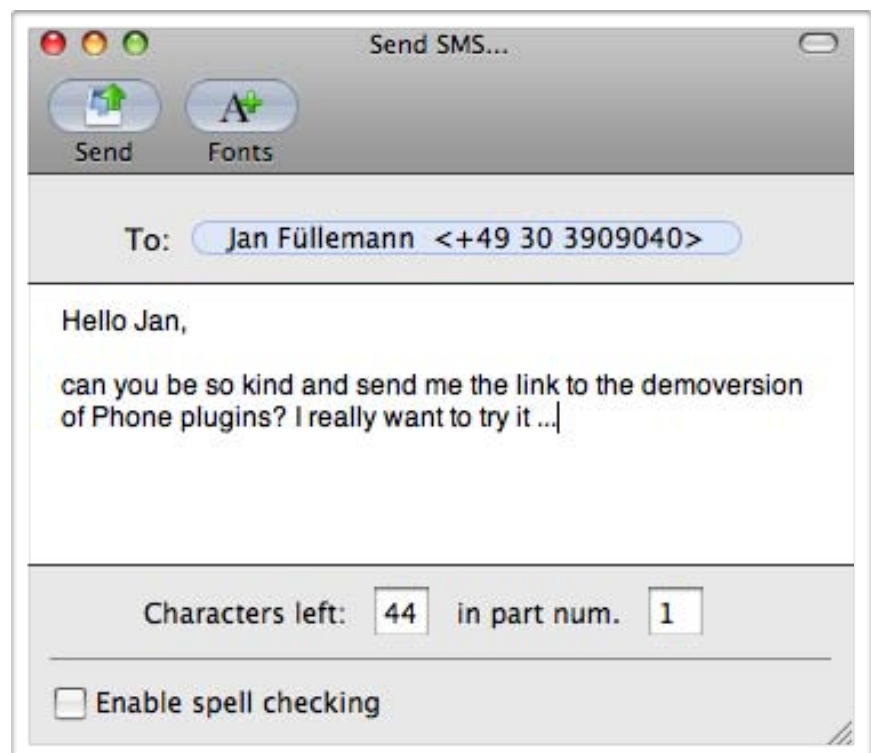

Quick-text from Address Book

To send a quick text message from the Address Book application, open the desired contact and click on the label of the phone number you want to send a text message to:



You will see a text message window on the screen:



Enter the desired text. If your text exceeds 160 characters, the message will be split into several text messages. You can see the number of left characters and the total number of text messages used for your message in the status line of the text message window.

Hit the 'Send' button to send the text message. Phone plugins will display the successful transmission:



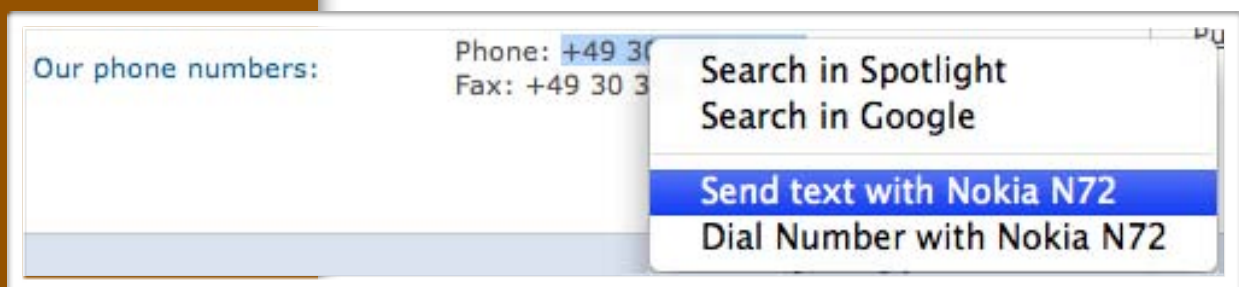
The message window will disappear after the text message has been sent.

Quick-text using context menu

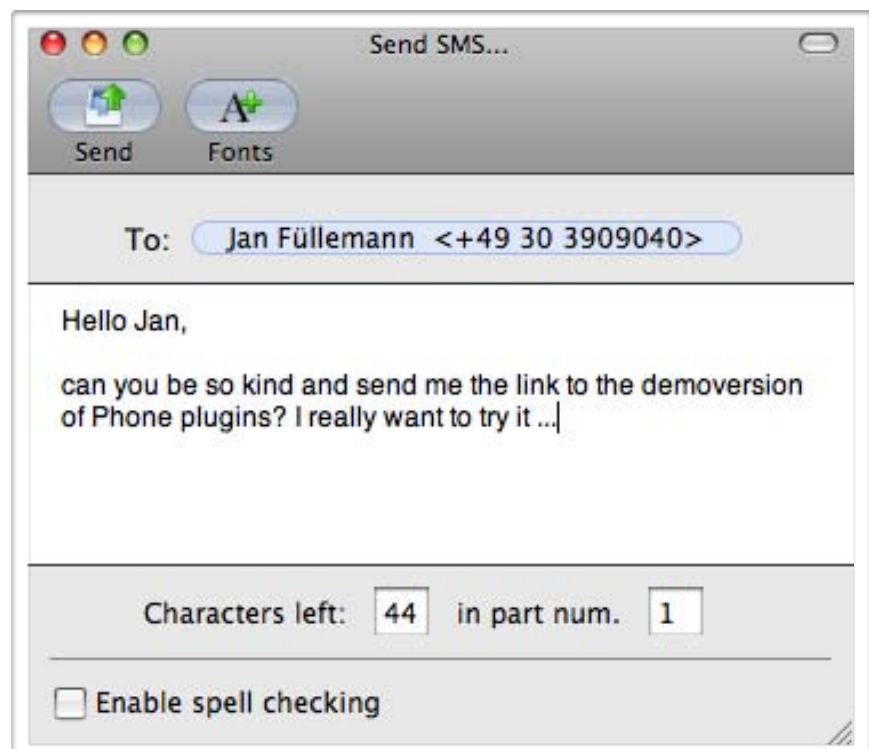
Phone plugins allows you to use the context menu to access the ,Dial' and ,Send text' commands.

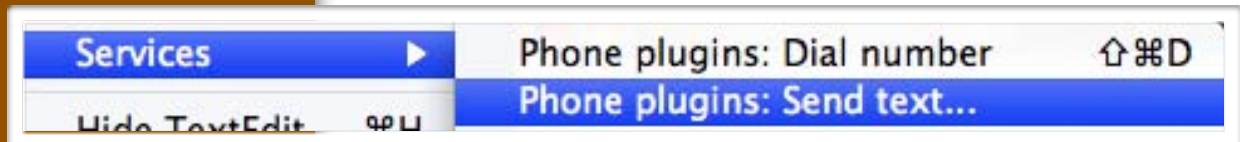


Quick-text using ,Services' menu

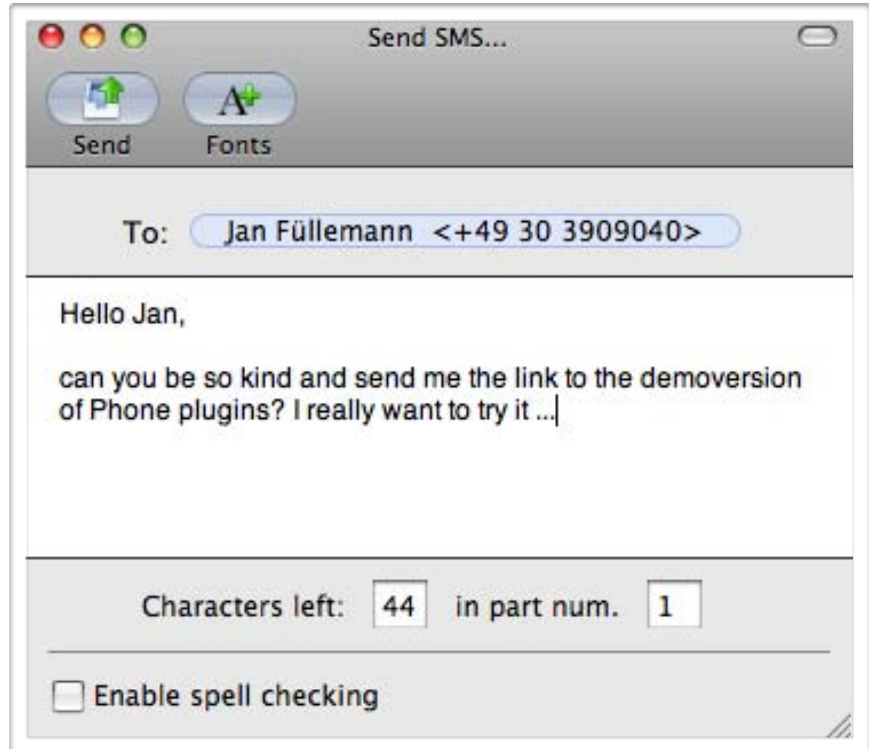
Within the application, select the number you want to send a text message to:



Then open the 'Services' menu and select ' Phone plugins: Send text...', :



You will see a new text message window on the screen.

Uninstall Phone plugins

To uninstall FoneLink, open the Applications folder. Then open the 'Phone plugins' folder. Doubleclick the 'Phone plugins Uninstall' icon to run the uninstaller.



The uninstaller will delete all Phone plugins files. You just have to trash 'Phone plugins Uninstall' to finish the uninstallation of phone plugins.

Attention: If you choose to uninstall Phone plugins, your license information will still be saved on this computer and you can not use your activation key on any other Macintosh.

Be sure to deactivate your license if you need to use Phone plugins on another computer.
