



Thank you very much for choosing message2net

With this software you can send, receive and manage SMS messages on your Macintosh. Further on, message2net facilitates a comfortable editing of contacts, names and numbers on a SIM Card as well as the exchange of mobile phone numbers from your Addressbook on your Mac OS X system with your SIM Card.


For these functions a compatible mobile phone must be connected to your Macintosh via Bluetooth. Please follow the manual in the last chapter “Support” to see how to connect a Mac with a mobile phone via Bluetooth.

Please note: In the free demo version, all sent SMS will include an additional text, and only 20 SMS messages can be sent in total. The phonebook functions are limited as well.

Follow the instructions on the next pages to get to know message2net.

message2net | First start

When being started for the first time, message2net will ask you about the mobile phone you want to use:

Please choose the appropriate phone in the first pulldown-menu and the phone's brand name - Motorola, Nokia, Siemens or Sony Ericsson - in the second one.

You can decide whether to keep the phone connected to have fast access or to establish a connection every time you want to access the phone to save battery.

The SMS-service center address is the number used for sending SMS, usually the default number provided by your mobile network operator. Do not alter it unless you are using a different SMS-provider.

Country-Code for national phonenumber is used for all telephone numbers which do not include any country code.


Confirm by clicking „OK“. message2net is now ready to be used and will ask you if you want to continue work in the demo version-mode, or if you want to activate message2net. You can read about this activation in the next chapter, or jump to „Application“ for using the demo version.

message2net | Activation and De-Activation

For unlimited use of message2net, the software must be activated on your Macintosh Computer. If you change your Macintosh Computer later on, you can de-activate the software on this machine and activate it again on the new Macintosh Computer. This way, you can protect your investment in message2net.

Activation of message2net

To activate message2net, you have to own an Activation Key and an Internet connection. If you own an Activation Key, go to “message2net” in the menu bar and choose “Activate...“.

message2net asks you to enter the Activation Key and your e-mail address. The e-mail address will only be used by nova media to identify you in case of support issues. This address will not be used for other purposes or given to any third party.

Accept the license agreement and click “Continue“. After a few seconds, message2net will be activated. Please click on “Finish” to convert message2net into a full version without restrictions.

Tip: An Activation Key can be purchased online immediatly: Go to www.novamedia.de to establish an online connection to our Webshop. After purchase, an E-Mail containing the Activation Key will be sent to you.

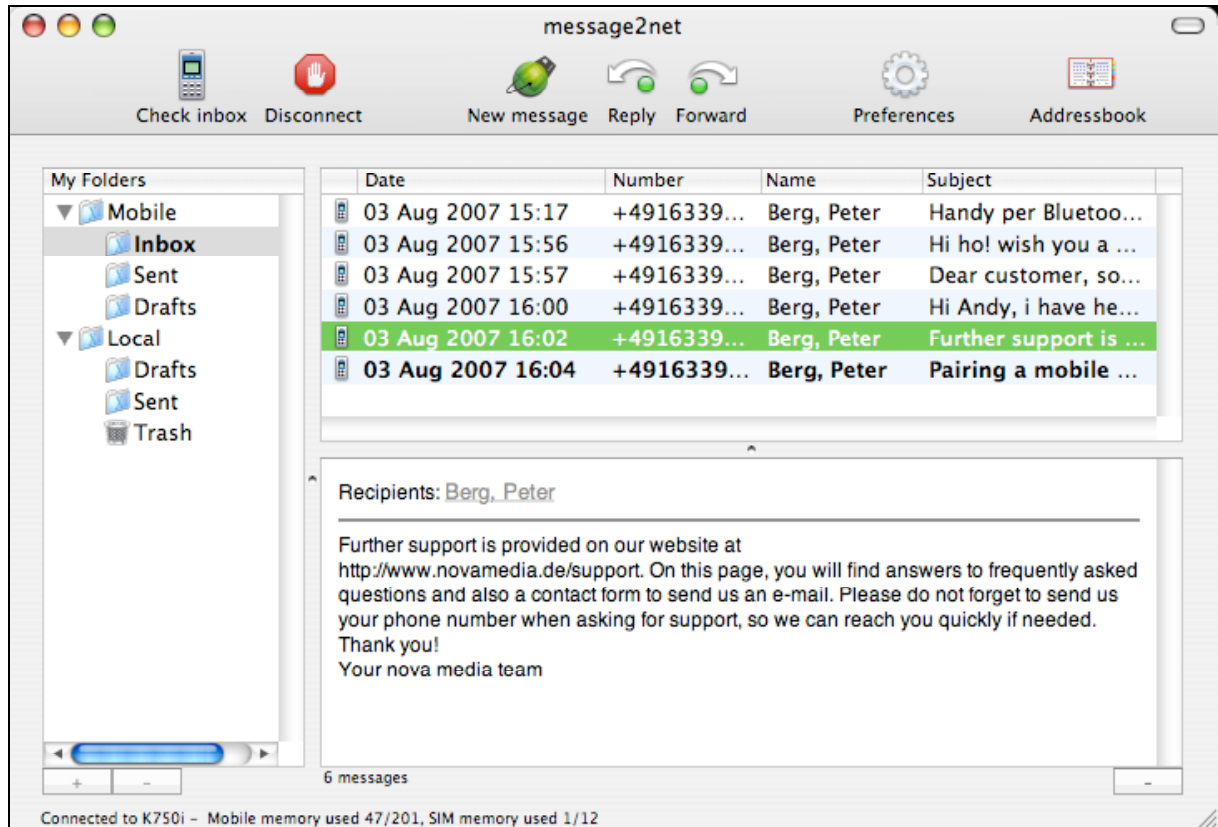
De-activation of message2net

To De-activate message2net, go to “message2net” in the menu bar and choose „De-Activate License...“. Click on “Deactivate”. message2net will now fall back into the demo mode but all your current data like backups or settings are saved.

You can either activate message2net on this computer again or activate message2net on another Macintosh Computer of your choice.

message2net | Application: SMS messages

Managing SMS messages



Retrieving SMS messages: With one click on the button „Check inbox“, all the SMS messages on your mobile phone will be loaded into the programme and put into the „Inbox“ folder. The SMS messages will not be deleted from your mobile phone in this process.

Displaying SMS messages: Click on the „Inbox“-folder and your SMS messages appear in the upper window on the right. When clicking on one of the messages, you can read the whole message text in the window below. After about 2 seconds, the message will be marked as read and will not be displayed in bold characters anymore. You can change this time at „Preferences“. Use the commands at item „Message“ in the menu bar to mark messages as „read“ or „unread“.

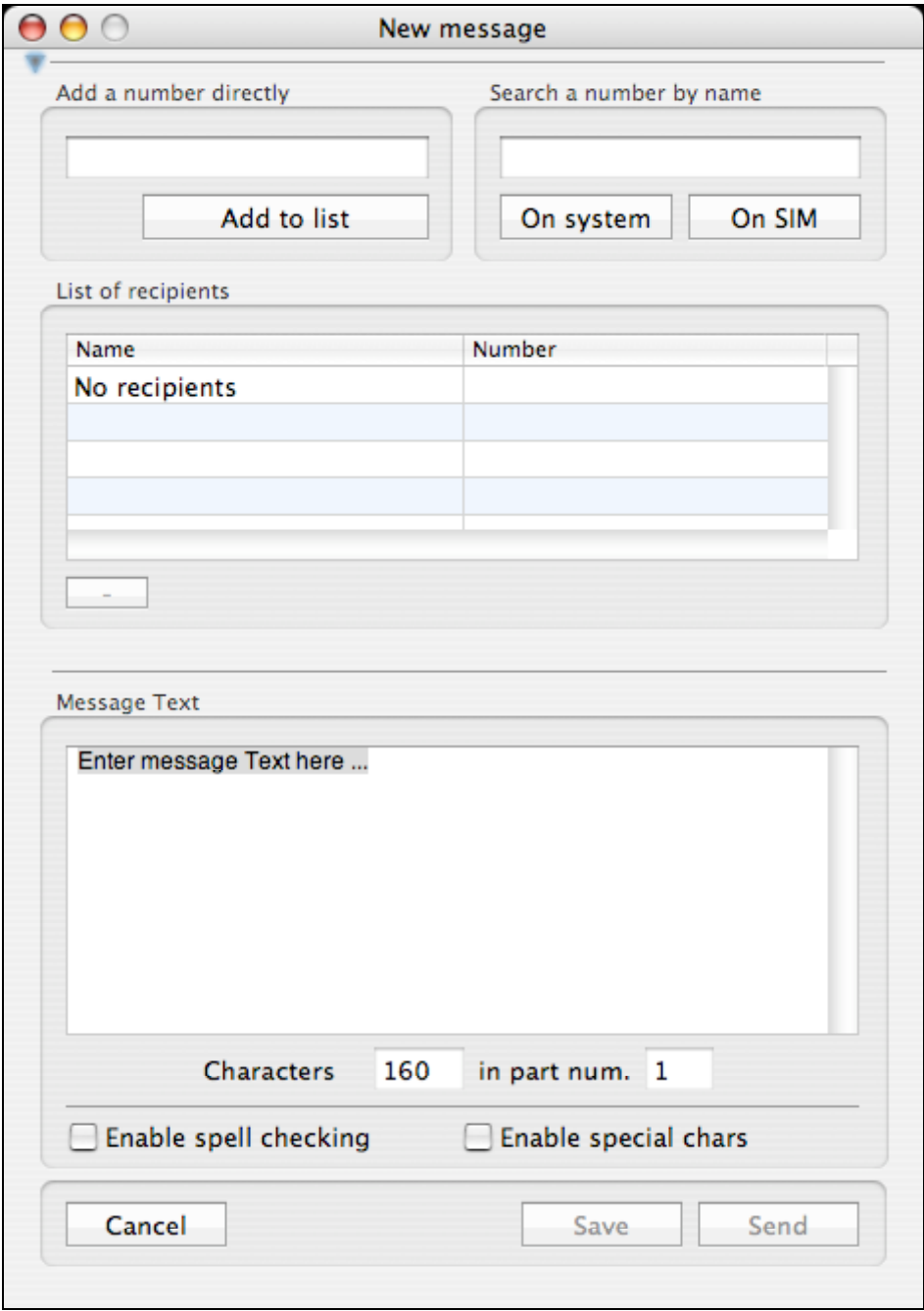
Please note: The time and date information for messages in the folders “Draft” and “Sent” on the mobile phone can not be displayed. The messages themselves are displayed properly.

Organizing SMS messages: Move a message from the „Inbox“-folder into any „Local“-subfolder. You can add as many folders as you wish to the „Local“-folder. For this, click on the „plus“ sign or choose the command „add new“ with the right mouse click. A folder can be moved into another folder, so you can e.g. build up a hierarchy for a certain topic.

Please note: An SMS message will be deleted from your mobile phone when you remove it from the „Inbox“ folder. It can not be put back again.

Deleting SMS messages: You can delete an SMS message by moving it into the „Trash“-folder and then emptying the folder. To do so, click on the „Trash“-folder with the right mouse click and choose „empty trash“. The messages are now deleted.

Composing, answering and forwarding SMS messages:



Composing a new SMS message:

Click the button „New message“ in the tool bar - a new message window will appear. Now you can insert a mobile phone number manually which will be put into the list of recipients with the command „add to list“. Alternatively, you can seek for a recipient in your Mac OS X address book or in contacts on your SIM Card. For this, just enter a part of the name into the search-field and click on the corresponding button for „On system“ or „On SIM“. A list of all entries that contain the search string will appear. Pick the decided phone number of intended recipient and click „Apply“. By clicking the „minus“-button, you can remove a selected entry from the recipient list.

Group SMS: One SMS message can be sent to up to 10 receivers at a time. You are free to compose the list of recipients out from manually entries, or entries from the address book or the SIM Card. This availability of this function is dependent on your phone model.

Multipart SMS: Write a message text that can be as long as 10 ordinary SMS messages without interruption. You can see the amount of SMS messages that will be needed in the field „in part nr“ below the message text. This availability of this function is dependent on your phone model.

Special characters: Some characters need to be converted in a different format to be able to send them via SMS. This conversion means that more characters are used than for a standard character. Thus any SMS containing special characters will be longer and under some circumstances 2 SMS messages are sent instead of one. These special characters are marked in red.

When your are done, click on „Save“ to save the SMS message in the „Draft“-folder or on „Send“ to dispatch the message.

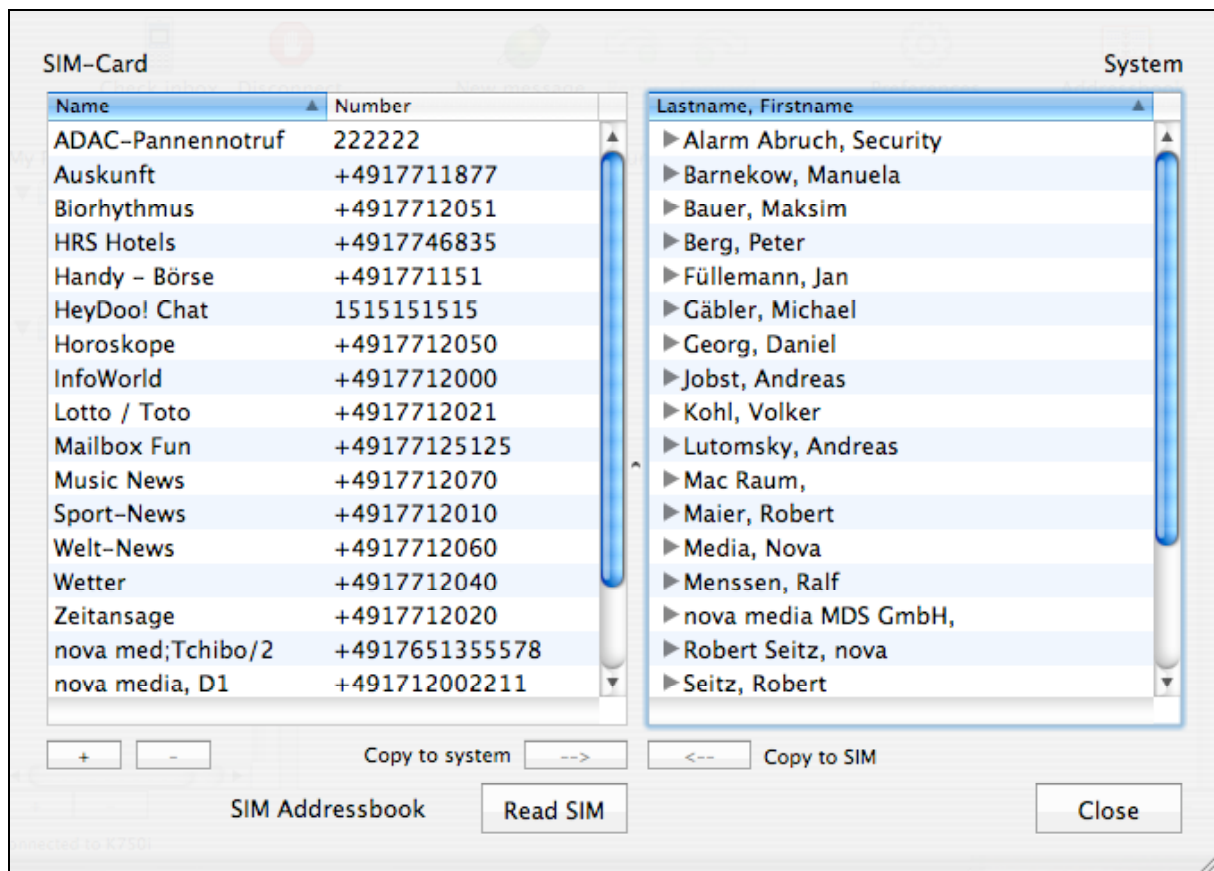
Replying to SMS messages:

Choose an SMS message, then click „Reply“ in the tool bar. The new message window will be displayed, with the recipient already inserted. You can add more recipients or just write the text, then you can send the SMS or save the text for later on.

Forwarding SMS messages:

Choose an SMS message, then click on „Forward“ in the tool bar. The new message window will be displayed, with the message text already inserted. Add one or more recipients and edit the text if needed. Now you can send the SMS message or save the text for later on.

message2net | Application: SIM Card functions



Managing SIM Card contacts:

Click the button „Addressbook“ in the tool bar to manage the contacts on your mobile phone's SIM Card. A new window will appear – displaying the contacts in your Mac OS X address book on the right and showing your SIM Card's contact list when clicking „read SIM“ on the left.

Now, you can copy names and numbers from the address book onto the SIM Card or from the SIM Card into the address book. For this, choose an entry and move it into the other list, alternatively click on the corresponding icon for „Copy to system“ or „Copy to SIM“.

You can add a number to an Addressbook contact as well. Just select the number in the left panel and drag it on top of the desired contact on the right – the number will be added to its contact information.

Editing SIM Card contacts:

With a double click on an SIM Card entry, you can edit this entry – change the name or the phone number.

Creating a new contact:

With one click on the „plus“ sign, you can create a new contact on the SIM Card. If you wish to use this contact in the Addressbook as well, just move it from the SIM Card contact list over to the Addressbook entries. To edit this new entry, use the functionality of the Addressbook.

How to pair a mobile phone and Mac via Bluetooth

In order to use your mobile phone with message2net you have to pair your Mac and mobile phone first. Please activate Bluetooth on your mobile phone and on your Mac. Then start the bluetooth assistant to begin the pairing process. To do so, open the System Preferences -> Bluetooth and choose the tab "Devices". Select "Configure new device". Follow the on-screen .

Important: You do **not** have to select any services. Press "Continue" until the assistant is finished. You do not need to enter any further data, like modem strings or usernames etc. After this pairing process is done and the assistant is closed, you can start message2net.
